

HOBSONVILLE POINT ROAD Living on the High Street

Hobsonville Point Road has been designed as a 'spine' road, based on other much loved streets like Richmond and Remuera Roads. It will become the community's 'high street' and will be lined with homes and small businesses and dotted with pockets of neighbourhood shops. The construction of the road will be complete by mid 2015.

The homes underway now on Hobsonville Point Road will offer Aucklanders something new and different; an urban lifestyle without the hassles of city-fringe living. Life on the high street will bring benefits to anyone who likes to be at the heart of the action.

Imagine... Everything you need within easy walking distance – cafes, shops, public transport, schools and parks – and a bustling and vibrant atmosphere each time you step out your front door.

Hobsonville Point Road is 2.5km long and runs from Hobsonville Village to The Landing.



LOOKING TO THE PAST TO CREATE A VIBRANT COMMUNITY

Many of Auckland's most loved streets grew up around the tramlines; electric trams were the city's main form of public transport between 1902 and 1956. People flocked to these streets to live near the tram stops. Pockets of small businesses and

shops flourished along the route, and in turn attracted more people to live and work on these high streets. Ponsonby and Mt Eden Roads are great examples. These old tramline routes are still at the heart of community life for locals.

Hobsonville Point Road has been designed on these same principles. The road will form the spine of our community, carrying traffic and pedestrians down to The Landing on the waterfront.

At the same time it will be a focal point for residents; a tree-lined, cycle and pedestrian-friendly avenue with less traffic and a greater emphasis on residential buildings.







STREAMLINE YOUR LIFE

Hobsonville Point Road breaks new ground for a Kiwi development by offering an urban-suburban lifestyle. Here are the four main types of houses being built on the street. Within these types there are countless variations in size and plan.



TERRACE

Hobsonville Point Road will have a range of terraces available from two to four storeys in height.

A terrace gives you the advantage of multiple living spaces on separate floors. You can achieve separation between bedrooms, and family members can enjoy private and shared areas. Terraces use less land, so you get more value from your budget, and their height allows for better views.



WORK FROM HOME

Some of the terraces have been designed with a flexible space on the ground floor that you can use as a home office.

Invest early and establish your business in a rapidly growing community that will soon be home to 10,000 people. The large, open space paired with a bathroom can be easily adapted to your needs, either now or later, becoming a teen hangout or an extra bedroom and/or living room.







WALK-UP

New to New Zealand but very popular overseas, walk-ups combine two homes in one building.

The ground floor is a one or two bedroom home, and there is a separate larger home which you walk up to on the upper level/s. Walk-ups use space economically so they can be offered at an attractive price. Living in the street level home can be compared to having an apartment on the ground, while the upstairs home benefits from the views elevation brings. Both offer an easy-care, low maintenance lifestyle.


APARTMENT
